Grafene is privately owned and managed by the Roden Family, Paul & Kathryn bought Losehill House Hotel & Spa in 2007 and have developed the hotel into the finest 4 star hotel & spa in the Peak District National Park. In 2016 they opened Grafene closer to home in Greater Manchester bringing their experience of running a 2 AA Rosette Restaurant at Losehill to Manchester's King Street.

Our wine philosophy is straightforward. In terms of style, we look for wines of balance, wines that are true to type, representative of their origins that complement our style of food. In terms of pricing, our aim is to offer excellent value at each price point.

To help in the selection process of our listed products, we work closely with our wine consultant and supplier, Miles Corish MW of Milestone Wines. Miles is one of only around 352 global Masters of Wine at the current time and over the last 25 years, has developed relationships with a strong portfolio of smaller, quality-focused wine producers. Wherever possible, we strive to

offer these quality products to our guests as it is our strong opinion that not only do smaller producers inevitably offer superior combinations of quality and value, many of those that appear in our list are benchmark producers for their region.

To make our wine index more accessible to our valued guests, we have listed our whites and reds into four "categories" or "styles". As wine taste is nearly always a subjective experience and there are seldom absolutes when categorising style, we understand that some individual wines may straddle more than one style category. We hope that you enjoy our selection and welcome your comments and feedback.

Renowned for their Proseccos, Mabis offers this hand harvested masterpiece. Elegant, delicate and aromatic, this fine Prosecco offers hints of apples and honeysuckle.

- 1 Louis Pommery Brut England. England, NV. 10.00 50.00**
The first English sparkling wine produced by the champagne house in the market, using grapes of a small production from Sussex, Essex and Hampshire, made at the Hattingley Valley Winery in Hampshire. Apple and dough notes in the nose with citrus lime and lemon on palate with a delicate salty note on the finish.
- 2 Baumard Brut. Loire, France. NV. 40.00**
Domaine Baumard has been practicing sustainable viticulture for over 50 years and is considered as one of the most leading producers in the whole of the Loire Valley. This sparkling wine presents a light straw color, mineral aromas with notes of apple and peach on the nose. Lemon, apple and pink grapefruit on the palate. The mousse is elegant with plenty of crisp acidity. The finish is long and dry with biscuity notes.

White Wines

140 Alheit Vineyards 'Cartology'. South Africa, 2014. 80.00

Since its inception in 2011, Cartology has lost none of its cachet and the wine they express continues to garner an ever-increasingly great reputation. Made only from a handful of mountain-side mature Chenin Blanc bush-vines, a true masterpiece is created. Enchanting flavours of quince, honey and hazelnut wrap the palate with a superb, sophisticated finish

Red Wines

146 Clos Vieux Taillefer. Pomerol, Bordeaux, France. 2010. 140.00

Beneath its deep ruby robe there exists a supple and full-bodied wine with notes of caramelised cherry mixed with mild spice and cinnamon. Notes of vanilla and cigar box entice the nose whilst firm, persistent tannins linger in a wonderfully long finish.

147 Bramare Luyan de Cuyo Malbec. Mendoza, Argentina. 2013. 160.00

Deep amethyst and ruby tones open into a refined nose of cassis and sweet strawberry. Developing into notes of caramel, white pepper and dark chocolate, this Malbec is a truly elegant wine. Firm, lasting tannins create a beautifully structured finish.

**148 Château Pontet-Canet 5eme Cru Classé.
Pauillac, Bordeaux, France. 2007. 160.00**

Red fruit dominates the nose with great roundness and perfume. The palate is full and opulent with persistent black cherry and much spice. Beautifully balanced, ripe tannins are well integrated with full and bracing acidity.



WHITE WINE

Crisp, Light and Mineral

Within this section, you will find wines that exhibit a zingy freshness. Most often these wines are dry, light-bodied, mostly unoaked and usually possess crisp levels of acidity. Given their overall structure, these wines are suitable to consume both on their own as an aperitif but also make great partners for white fish, shellfish and dishes with acidic elements such as vinaigrettes.

31 Bella Modella Pinot Grigio.(Vegan) Umbria, Italy. 2016. 4.75 6.25 25.00

A beautifully light, vibrant white to be appreciated for its zesty, citrus and green apple character with refreshing quality.

32 Famille Morin Picpoul de Pinet. (Vegan) Languedoc, France. 2016. 28.00

A bright wine with fresh aromas of white flower, acacia and hawthorn. A fresh and saline palate with a surprisingly rounded finish for a Picpoul.

33 Mabis 'Uvam' Pinot Grigio. Veneto, Italy. 2016. 28.00

An ambrosial nose of floral aromas with melon and peach, supported by fresh acidity. A light and definitive wine for any occasion.

5 Albourne Estate Bacchus. Sussex, United Kingdom. 2016. 39.00

A refreshing and crisp palate with upfront aromas of cut grass, elderflower and gooseberry on the nose. Beautifully balanced and poised. One of Grafene's favourites.

6 Albourne Estate White Pinot Noir. Sussex, United Kingdom. 2016. 40.00

An elegant wine with lively acidity. The whole-bunch pressed Pinot Noir grapes have produced a pale, soft rose tint with hints of cherry blossom and rose petal on the nose.

34 Domaine Tremblay Chablis. Burgundy, France. 2015. 40.00

A fantastic expression of Chablis Chardonnay. It's producers, Tremblay, are a revered boutique wine house with a great reputation in the region. These high level producers handcraft top examples of this classic style. Stone fruit, hints of flint and an appley finish.



WHITE WINE

Aromatic Whites

“Aromatic” white wine styles tend to be naturally pungent; often created from grape varieties whose inherent perfumes shine through in the glass. In contrast, more “neutral” styles of white are often made with grape varieties that possess less natural perfume and sometimes owe more to external influences such as oak barrel ageing and other winemaking techniques. Aromatic styles make ideal partners for dishes with reasonably strong flavours, creating a great foil for spicy dishes or those that have a certain degree of sweetness.

40 Pacifico Sur Sauvignon Blanc. Curico Valley, Chile. 2016. 4.50 6.00 24.00

This fantastic wine is pale lemon in colour with bags of tropical fruit flavour, background citrus notes and a long, elegant finish.

41 Mont Rocher Viognier.(Vegan) Pays D’Herault, France. 2016. 5.50 6.75 27.00

A lasting honeysuckle and apricot aroma with a rich, almost unctuous palate that is still dry, tangy and refreshing.

42 Fairhall Downs Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand. 2016. 7.00 8.50 35.00

From one of the first growers of the region in 1982, this family estate creates small-quantity top-notch Marlborough Sauvignon. An intense passionfruit, guava and tomato stalk on the nose marries together with a complex and delicately poised palate. Superb finish.

48 The Courtesan, Reisling. (Vegan). Clare Valley, Australia 30.00

Capturing all the mouth-watering lime and elderflower character one expects from a great Riesling, the Courtesan has a voluptuous palate hinting at pomelo, ripe melon and quince.

43 Chateau Ka ‘Source Blanche’.(Veg.) Bekaa Valley, Lebanon. 2013. 37.00

This unusual blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier, Muscat and Chardonnay creates an exceptionally satisfying wine. Floral and citrusy with great depth of character.

44 Donnhoff Riesling Dry. Nahe, Germany. 2016. 40.00

From one of the most widely regarded producers of dry Riesling in the world, this stunning wine is only offered to select venues. Wonderfully fresh and well defined with elegant and lasting minerality. A delicious and captivating wine. A real treat.



45 Joseph Cattin Grand Cru Gewurztraminer. Alsace, 2015. 42.00

The Cattin family has been established in Alsace for over three centuries and their high quality wine expressions match their experience in production. Combining hedonistic notes of Turkish delight, lychee and mandarine, this is a brilliant wine.

46 Domäne Wachau Smaragd Riesling. Wachau, Austria. 2015. 45.00

Powerful and fruit-driven on the nose with hints of stone fruits such as peach and apricot. The palate has expressive fruit aromas and a juicy, clean finish.

47 Domaine Crochet 'Los Perrios' Sancerre Blanc. Loire, France. 2014. 50.00

The nose is fresh, pure and elegant with blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry. Fresh citrus fruit acidity supports stony minerality on the palate.



WHITE WINE

Soft and Rounded Whites

Typically, this style of white wine isn't always noticeably aromatic; tending to be slightly more full-bodied and in some cases, containing a little less prominent acidity than other categories. Given their structure, they lend themselves to partnering slightly heavier dishes than other styles. One of the more versatile white styles in our list, "rounded" whites can match a wide range of foods. Enjoy with fish, salads and light risottos, or simply on their own.

50 Simonsvlei Chardonnay. South Africa. 2016. 5.00 6.50 26.00

Attractive melon and citrus notes on the nose with apricot and mandarin flavours on the palate. A lovely, rich Chardonnay that is beautifully refreshing related to its crisp acidity.

55 Silga, Bodegas Alvarez y Diez Verdejo.(Vegan) Rueda, Spain. 2016. 28.00

With a combination of old vines grapes from Ribera del Duero, it delivers pronounced notes of green-fruit aromas with a subtle over notes of citrus and rhubarb. A lovely dry and refreshing wine with a good balance of acidity and a long finish, 100%Verdejo

51 Domäne Wachau Gruner Veltliner.(Vegan) Wachau, Austria. 2015. 35.00

Aromas of white pepper, delicate herbal notes and hints of ripe yellow apple. Crisp acidity and juicy fruit flavours are followed by a spicy finish on the palate.

52 Pazo Señorans Albariño. Rias Baixas, Spain. 2015. 40.00

Aromas of nectarine, fresh fig and white fruit. Dry, citric flavours encompass a mineral driven finish which expands and deepens with a satisfying balance of power and finesse.

53 Chamonix Reserve Chardonnay. Franschhoek Valley, S. Africa. 2014. 55.00

From the renowned wine maker of Chamonix, Gottfried Mocke, comes this excellent Chardonnay expression. Embracing modern methods with a firm respect for nature taking its natural course, this is an award-winning wine. Intense tropical fruit, sweet ginger spice and notes of oaty toastiness. Well-structured with soft citurs and good minerality on the finish.

54 Domaine Defaix 'Côte de Lechet' Chablis 1er Cru.(Vegan) France, 2014. 65.00

The remarkable stony soils of the vineyards of Chablis are captured in this powerful and complex wine. Flourishing with age, this beautiful wine expresses mineral aromas, reminiscent of gunflint.



WHITE WINE

Rich and Full Whites

Styles of this category tend to fall on the “weightier” end of the scale in terms of body and are ideal for those who prefer full, creamy and mouth-filling wines. Invariably, these varieties will have usually undergone some degree of barrel fermentation or ageing and tend to be derived from grape varieties known for their ability to produce rich, mouth-coating wine. Wines such as these are able to partner strong flavoured food such as char-grilled and smoked meats, salmon and even pork.

60 Bodegas Luis Cañas Rioja Blanco.(Vegan) Rioja, Spain. 2015. 32.00

A beautifully balanced example of a white Rioja that combines both old and new styles. Vibrant, citrusy Viura is blended with weightier Malvasia that undergoes brief barrel maturation adds a honeyed, structural roundness.

61 Collefrisio Pecorino. Abruzzo, Italy. 2015. 37.00

Previously thought to be extinct, the Pecorino grape was found growing wild in the Marche region. These were then isolated and replanted, resulting in this wonderful grape’s recent revival. Full bodied with hints of nectarine, ginger and white pepper. The palate lasts with just the right amount of refreshing acidity. Wonderful stuff.

62 Domaine Drouin Pouilly Fuissé “Metertières”. Burgundy, France. 2015. 52.00

Planted on the limestone-derived soils of this classic terroir, this Pouilly Fuissé is one of the stars of the region with only tiny quantities making it to the UK each year. Rich, creamy peach and nectarine flavours flood the palate. With the excellent acidity afforded to the region by the vintage, this is an experience worth trying.

63 Domaine Louis Clerc Condrieu. Rhône Valley, France. 2015. 70.00

Ran by a small mother and son team, this wine house only produces very small amounts of this expression every year. Full bodied and markedly pungent, this is a huge step up from classic Viognier. Combined with a beautiful creamy texture, this Condrieu offers freshness and vivacity with hints of pebble and dried apricot. Stunning.

64 Domaine Pinson ‘Les Clos’ Chablis Grand Cru. Burgundy, France. 2013. 80.00

This Grand Cru Chablis is rich, elegant and yet firmly structured. Offering classically styled and distinctive flavours, this fine wine offers immense complexity and length.

65 Alain Chavy Puligny Montrachet 2015. Burgundy, France. 2015. 85.00

A bright lemon colour leads onto a nose that combines white peach, hints of citrus and lightly toasted hazelnuts. The palate is seamless with a wonderful balance between, ripe fruit, crisp acidity and superbly integrated French oak (only 25% new)



ROSÉ WINE

7 Sugarbird Blush White Zinfandel.(Veg) California, USA. 2016. 4.50 6.00 24.00

This vivid pink, fruit driven wine is an excellent example of Californian Rosé. Easy drinking and wonderfully fragrant, it offers enticing notes of ripe berry, sweet bonbon and cherry. An excellent example of White Zinfandel in its best condition.

8 Mabis 'Uvam' Pinot Grigio Blush.(Vegan) Veneto, Italy. 2015. 5.00 6.50 28.00

A fine and elegant nose supported by fruit-led and flowery notes. This wine is captured by a light, copper hue with a well-balanced and persistently fruity finish.

9 Château Montaud Côtes De Provence. Provence, France. 2016. 30.00

This crisp, off-dry wine is a classic example of a Provence rosé wine. It is light and fresh with a pleasant, lingering tang that gives life to bright red fruit with attractive acidity. Herby, mineral flavours are well met in well-defined finish.



RED WINE

Light, Elegant and Easy Reds

Red wines within this section display fresh fruit aromas and a softness that makes them great to drink both on their own or with lighter styles of food. Whilst lovers of “big” reds may sometimes leave these styles overlooked, they do deserve a place on every wine list. The juicy fruit flavours and intrinsic, refreshing acidity of these reds allow them to be a suitable match for many varieties of food including poultry, pastas and creamy cheese.

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A powerful nose of violets and red fruits. This medium bodied wine possesses soft fruit and plum aromas.

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Sancerre of this variety continues to go from strength to strength in terms of popularity and quality due to its ability to produce excellent expressions of Pinot Noir. This is a fine example of such. Delicate red cherry and red currant flavours combine with crisp acidity to form a delicious, medium-bodied red.

75	Domaine Jaeger-Defaix Rully 1er Cru Rouge.	Burgundy, France. 2015.			60.00
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This fine, elegant Clos du Chapite is a classically Burgundian style of Pinot Noir. Aromas of red and black fruit dominate the nose with violets and cherry in abundance. Fine, supple tannins and a refreshing acidity on the palate make this a truly remarkable wine.



RED WINE

Spicy and Rounded Reds

“Spicy” reds cover a wide range of grape varieties, aromas and flavours. These wines are characterised by medium tannins and generally possess a softer, more rounded mouth feel. Spicy, rounded wines are therefore suitable for a wide range of foods ranging from poultry to lighter red meat dishes such as lamb, through to charcuterie.

An eager nose of sweet tobacco, plum and blackberry develops into a spicy, bodied mouth-feel at tasting. A productive grape with great tenacity and length.

81 Odfjell ‘Armador’ Carmenere.(Veg)	Maipo, Chile. 2016.	29.00
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A medley of aromas from blackberry and dark chocolate to more savoury, meaty tones. The palate displays ripe dark fruits but also coffee and liquorice. Ripe tannins offer solid structure and a complex, elegant finish endures.

82 Domaine des Pesquiers Cotes du Rhone Villages.	Rhone, France. 2016.	33.00
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Described as a “baby” Châteuneuf du Pape, this wine is rich and complex yet approachable. Dark fruit, cherry, spice and liquorice both on the nose and the palate.

84 Col d’Arribat AOC St Chinian-Roquebrun.	Languedoc, France. 2014.	30.00
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From the oldest part of Languedoc, Cave de Roquebrun is of a higher altitude in the St-Chinian region, thus explaining this wine’s marked finesse. A fine blend of Shiraz, Grenache and Mouvedre, this stylish wine offers black fruit, tapenade and hints of spice and coffee. Medium to full bodied and perfect with rustic food types.

85 Dominio de Cair ‘Cair’.	Ribera del Duero, Spain. 2012.	50.00
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Deep ruby in colour, offering an intensifying nose of fine wood, chocolate and fruit. Full and powerful, this elegantly balanced wine combines excellence and quality in good measure. Soft, smooth tannin on the finish.

86 ‘Thousand Candles’.	Yarra Valley, Australia. 2013.	70.00
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This excellent, award-winning wine offers a wonderful bouquet of flavour and aromas. Syrah, Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc are blended to formulate a punchy nose of violet, exotic spice and black fruit with an embracing and structural finish.



RED WINE

Full-bodied Reds

Full bodied reds are mouth-coating; a result of wine made from 'weightier' grape varieties or wine that has spent some time in oak barrels. Usually containing moderate to high levels of tannin, wines such as these cover a wide spectrum of colours; not just deep red. Furthermore, they make more than suitable partners to stronger foods. Try with red meats such as beef and venison, or with hard cheese and chocolate.

89 Incayal Malbec. Mendoza, Argentina. 2015. 5.50 7.00 30.00

In the right hands of a quality producer, Malbec can produce wonderfully rich, full flavoured reds with velvet-like texture. Located in the premier zone of Lujan de Cuyo, Incayal creates a complex wine loaded with plums, spice and hints of vanilla.

90 Ironstone Vineyards Old Vine Zinfandel Lodi, California, U.S.A 32.00

From vineyard 45 years old, comes an exceptional varietal character. Flavours of blackberry, ripe plum and fresh, red raspberry mingle with subtle pepper spice. A smooth, silky finish with unprecedented depth. Ironstone Vineyards is part of California's sustainable wine growing programme. Grape varieties: 90% Zinfandel, 5% Petite Sirah and 5% Shiraz.

91 Bodegas Amaren Rioja Crianza. Rioja Avesa, Spain. 2012. 40.00

Deep ruby colour with a clean, balsamic nose and nuances of plum and clean oak. Smooth, toasted oak lingers on a fruit-driven finish with hints of eucalyptus.

92 Monte Bernardi Retromarcia Chianti Classico. Tuscany, Italy. 2013. 44.00

Under the stewardship of a tight-knit sibling-ran wine house, the Schmelzer family have created a wonderfully bright, juicy and superbly balanced example of Sangiovese. Characterised by sour cherry and a savoury texture that cries out for traditional Tuscan fare. Beautiful.
